2009

Heating Green and Lummi Nation partnered to design and supply heating systems for a variety of projects.



2009-10

Kwina Village Phase 1: Designed and supplied 336 heating panels and thermostats for 72 apartments.



2013-14

Designed and supplied approximately 200 heating panels and thermostats for 16 brand new homes.

Smokehouse Village Project: Retrofitted 24 apartments from propane heaters to electric infrared heaters.



2014-15

Kwina Village Phase 2: Designed and supplied 250 panels and thermostats for 46 new apartments.

Balch Road Project: Nine family residences retrofit from propane heaters to infrared heating panels.

Whatasen Lane project:
Four single family residences
Retrofit from an inefficient furnace
to infrared heating panels.
